

Take notice that on 7 June 2006 an application was received by Berwick-upon-Tweed Borough Council (the licensing authority), under section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003, for the review of the premises licence in respect of **Pizza Plus, 1 Golden Square, Berwick-upon-Tweed TD15 1BG.**

The grounds for review of the premises licence being that the premises have not been operated in a way that promoted the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance.

Anyone may make a representation in respect of the application for review, but the licensing authority can only consider representations relating to the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm (the licensing objectives) made by “responsible authorities”; anyone living or working in the vicinity of the premises or a body representing such residents or businesses, known as “interested parties”; or the licence holder.

Representation must be made in writing and received by the Licensing Section, Legal and Democratic Services Unit, Berwick-upon-Tweed Borough Council, Council Offices, Wallace Green, Berwick-upon-Tweed TD15 1ED by **no later than 5 July 2006.**

The licensing authority’s register, which shall include a record of the application for review, is kept at Berwick-upon-Tweed Borough Council, Council Offices, Wallace Green, Berwick-upon-Tweed TD15 1ED and may be inspected there during normal office hours.

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application, which could result in prosecution and a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale (£5000).
